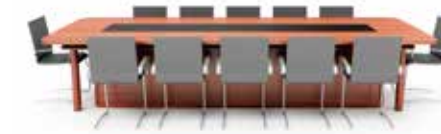

In 2018, Netivot will open a third Primary classroom for the very first time. Expanding our early childhood level is one of the most strategic ways to ensure the continuity of our elementary program through robust enrollment. Our goal is to have three Primary classes with approximately 25 students in each. Creating a brand new classroom in a Jewish Montessori school is a lofty undertaking! It requires the purchase of a full complement of Jewish and General Montessori materials, beautiful new bookshelves, tables and chairs, rugs, shelves, wall décor, etc.

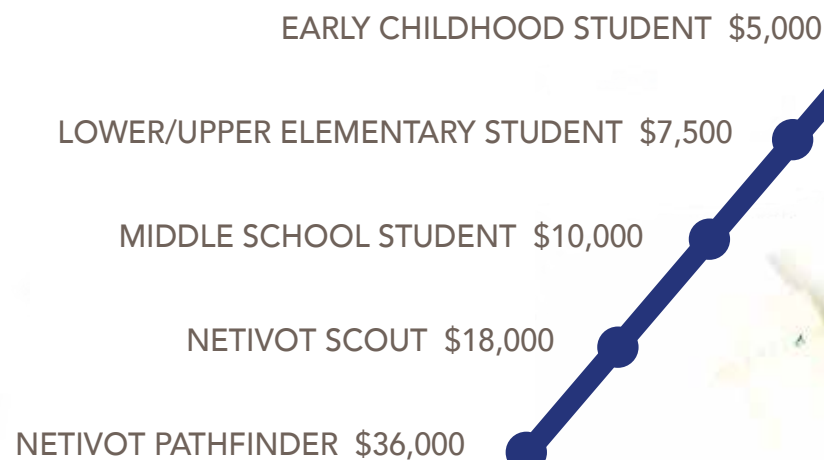


GIVE THE GIFT OF JEWISH MONTESSORI EDUCATION

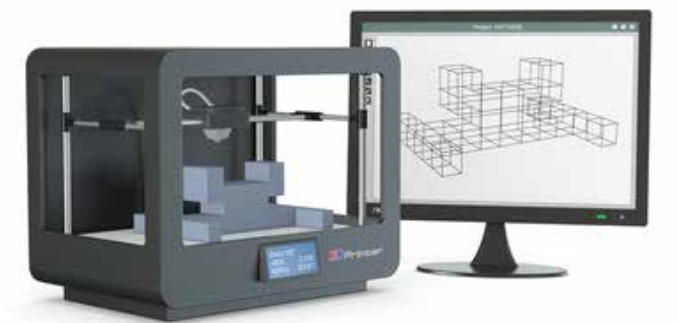
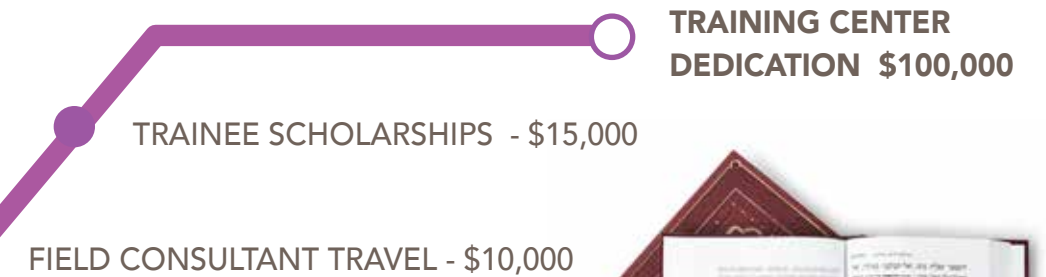
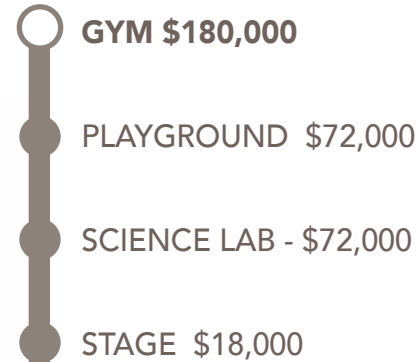
In 2016-17 we allocated \$250,000 toward tuition assistance. Approximately 40% of Netivot students receive some percentage of reduction. Most applicants receive between 10% and 35%, and a few families experiencing significant financial hardship receive as much as 65%. Even families struggling to get by express that they are happy to pay as much as they can toward a Netivot education. Our goal is to establish a substantial fund to help these families offer their children the best Jewish education available.

3D PRINTER \$5,000

A cornerstone of the Jewish Montessori method is the use of miniature objects. Tiny items are used for identifying starting sounds and for spelling out full words with the moveable alphabet. Miniature environments are used for the development of vocabulary in English, Hebrew and Chumash, and even in higher grades, small scale objects are used to help students visualize things like the vessels of the Mishkan. With a high quality 3D printer, our curriculum department and faculty can produce works for our own classrooms as well as other schools around the country.
